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Anita Steinwider lives and works as a freelance artist in Vienna. After completing her degree in architecture at the Technical University of Graz in 2000, she founded the label STEINWIDDER in 2002. For 15 years, she explored clothing as both a sculptural object and a medium for social reflection. Her conceptual collections were based on discarded textiles, which she used to address ecological and social issues. Her work has been presented internationally in projects, exhibitions, and fashion shows.

Since 2014, her artistic focus has shifted to the visual arts: She combines found objects with textile techniques to create sculptural works, assemblages, and installations at the intersection of material research, cultural memory, and narrative object design.
